

ALL Students should arrive on time for morning assembly


Morning Assembly/Drop - Off:

- Grades 1-5 School ends at 3:45 P.M.


If picking your child up early, you must sign them out from the office administration.




STUDENT ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS



- Designated Drop off Zones – Please Don't get out of the car
- Park if you want to walk the student in
- Designated Pick up Zones – Don't get out of the car
- Park if you want to walk in to pick your child up or speak with a Teacher



ESSENTIAL FOR TRAFFIC FLOW

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

- Students must wear seat belts every time throughout the journey
- Each bus has a designated Nanny, who enforces school bus safety. Students are required to follow and obey the safety rules given. Refusal to follow these rules may result in student forfeit of school bus service, no refunds given.
- Students should not rough house or be excessively loud on the school bus
- School bus drivers will follow established safety procedures before, during, and concluding the assigned trips.
- Parents are required to come to the school bus and collect their children at the conclusion of the trip, in order for the ACIS staff to remain with other children on the bus.




UNIFORMS & DRESS CODE

- *Dress Code is enforced




MEDICATION & ALLERGIES

MEDICATION



- Any medications for students should be given to the Nurse
- Teachers may not give medicine to students
- Students with fevers – Parents will be called to pick the child up
- Students not picked up must remain in the nurses' office
- If a child is sick at home with fever, vomiting, or diarrhea the night before please keep them home for at least 24 hours.

- Please notify your child's homeroom teacher and the school bus of any allergies
- Please fill out the medical information sheet

ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

AMERICAN SUBJECTS

- American curriculum is derived mainly from the national Common Core standards. These standards emphasize critical thinking, creativity and collaborative learning among students.
- English Language Arts, Math, Science, Health, & Social Studies are all taught to these standards and principles.

Chinese language classes are divided into 3 different classes:


1. Chinese for beginners, focusing on pinyin



BASIC INFORMATION




- Digital reading platform



CURRICULUM – THAI LANGUAGE

- Thai language classes are divided into 3 different classes:
 1. Thai language non-Thai beginners (called “TF” course)
 2. Thai language for intermediate non-Thai learners (called “TF” course)
 3. Advanced Thai for Thai national students (called “Thai/Thai” course)

**Foreign students : grades K-8 must study Thai 1 period/week

**Thai students : grades K-12. must study Thai 5 periods/week



Floor Plan







THE PARENT-TEACHER GROUP (PTG)


The ACIS **PARENT-TEACHER GROUP (PTG)** is a forum for sharing ideas and discussing solutions to help the school manage and overcome challenges.

The group's objectives are to promote communication between parents, teachers, and administrative staff; to promote cooperation between parents and the School Board; to promote understanding and good will between ACIS and the community at large; and to promote and actively support the educational programs of ACIS. Teachers, administrators, and parents / guardians of ACIS students automatically become members of the PTG when they join the school.

PARENT-TEACHER GROUP (PTG) COMMITTEE



PARENT-TEACHER GROUP (PTG) is a 'Committee' of elected members, chosen by the School Board, whose positions rotate every year or two years.



The inaugural PTG at ACIS shall, however, be appointed in the interim by the **SCHOOL BOARD** in order to establish the preliminary structures, procedures and scope of the PTG, and provide the School Board with a key management support mechanism.

THE MAIN AIMS OF THE PTG ARE:

- To develop and maintain mutually positive relationships and communication between parents and the school
- To share information, suggestions and advice, and provide feedback on the operations and programs of the school
- To raise funds to support special school activities
- To support the school on special occasions
- To help promote and support the school mission, vision, and values

All parents are invited to attend the PTG meetings, held on the first Monday of every month. By taking an active role in the school, and influencing policy, organizing events, offering time, resources and skills, not only will all the children benefit, the entire school community will grow, becoming stronger and more effective at the same time. The PTG will meet quarterly.




