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Club Name	Description
Art	Students will complete art – related projects each week, grade – level appropriate. Art – related projects include multiple art disciplines, including painting, drama, etc.
Band	Students must have their own instrument in order to participate in band. Acceptable instruments include clarinet, flute, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, etc. Contact music@acis.ac.th for more information.
Chinese	Students learn different aspects of Chinese language and culture.
Clayworks	This club is sponsored by Clayworks Co. They bring their own staff and materials and give our students an opportunity to be creative, build their own ideas and teach them how to use clay as art.
Coding	This club is for students who had previously purchased a Microbit set from the school in January. In this club, students learning the basic of coding.
Games	In games club, students will practice verbal communication, critical thinking as they play different board games together with their sponsor.
Gigo Prep	This club is for students who had previously signed up for the Go Mech Gigo competition. This competition is being rescheduled. We would like to begin practicing in preparation for the new date (this club, taken on its own is free for participants).
Homework	This club is intended to provide general help to students who are struggling with particular homework assignments. It provides a quiet environment for students to work on their homework as well.
Music	In this club student practice basic music concepts.
Outdoor Sports & Games	In this club students practice gross motor skills, coordination through obstacle courses and similar styled outdoor games.
Reading	In this club students have an opportunity to develop their passions for reading. They will have quiet to time to read on their own, practice story-telling skills, and learn to speak in front of other students.
Sports	In this club students play team sports and build focus on building their skills in specific sports such as volleyball and soccer.
STEM Builders	In this club students explore and use building and engineering concepts to create free-build projects.
Thai	Students learn different aspects of Thai language and culture.
