Registration Information, Club Requirements, and Guidelines

- 🐼 Clubs run February 2 – June 11, from 3:45 – 4:45, approximately 12 sessions total
- 🐼 We kindly ask parents to pick students up from clubs promptly between 4:45 – 5:00 each day
- 🐼 Payment options include: 4 days (Monday – Thursday) for 6,500 baht per semester or 2,000 baht per club
- 🐼 Clayworks is 5,000 baht additional charge
- 🐼 Clubs must have 5 students on the roster before opening, and we have various capacity limits (based on classroom size, available supervision, etc.)
- 🐼 Once we confirm that your child's club has enough students to open, we will inform you so that you can come and pay.
- 🐼 **Sports Teams are a free program; participation is based on student ability to demonstrate talent towards the specific sport (try-out), and is available to K3 – G6 students only.*
